Professor Alastair V Campbell is a Visiting Professor of Medical Ethics and the Emeritus Director of the Centre for Biomedical Ethics in the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine of the National University of Singapore. Previously he was Professor of Biomedical Ethics, University of Otago and then Professor of Ethics in Medicine, University of Bristol. He is a former President of the International Association of Bioethics. He is a recipient of the HK Beecher Award, a Fellow of the Hastings Centre, New York and of the Ethox Centre, University of Oxford, and an elected Fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh. His recent books include *Health as Liberation* (1996), *Medical Ethics* (with D.G. Jones and G. Gillet, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition 2005), *The Body in Bioethics* (2009) and *Bioethics: the Basics* (second edition 2017). For the past few years he has been an advisor to the Bioethics Centre in the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
