Dr. Lee is working developing end-of-life care policy of Korea since 2010, when he joined the Bioethics Policy Research Center (now Korea National Institute for Bioethics Policy). He surveyed clinical ethics services in the academic hospital settings and drafted Korean end-of-life care act (legislated in Feb. 2016).
