Chih-hsing Ho, LL.M., J.S.M., Ph.D. is an Associate Research Fellow/ Associate Professor at the Institute of European and American Studies and the Research Center for Information Technology Innovation (joint appointment), Academia Sinica, Taiwan. Her research focuses on the nexus of law and medicine in general, with particular attention to the governance of genomics and newly emerging technologies, such as biobanks, big data and artificial intelligence (AI). She has been appointed to the Taiwan Ministry of Health and Welfare's Biobank Ethics and Governance Council, and the Consultation and Review Board of the National Biobank Consortium in Taiwan. She also serves at the National Health Insurance Administration's Legal Advisory and AI Data Access Committees. She holds a Ph.D. in law from the London School of Economics (LSE) where she was Olive Stone Scholar and Morris Finer Scholar. She obtained her first law degree from Taiwan, and later received her LL.M. from Columbia Law School and a J.S.M. from Stanford Law School. Before moving back to Taipei in 2014, she had been working at the Centre for Medical Ethics and Law (CMEL) at the University of Hong Kong. Her works appear in many renowned international journals, such as *Nature Genetics*, *BMC Medical Ethics*, *Computer Law & Security Review*, *Medical Law International*. Since 2016, she has served as an Associate Editor for ELSI in Science and Genetics- *Frontiers*.
